Essential Job Functions

Equipment Repair

- Tear down, utilizing manufacturer's recommendations and industry best practices
- Inspection of equipment and parts for wear and damage
- Diagnose for possible reason(s) for failure
- Provide information on parts and additional work required
- Provide recommendations to improve the reliability of the equipment
- Complete information in reports as required
- Paint and prepare for shipment
- Load, secure to truck, and deliver, as necessary
- Clean and organize shop, as required

Requirements

- Comply with all JCI Industries Inc. and OSHA Safety Regulations
- Mechanical aptitude and skills.
- Experience in maintenance and mechanical equipment repair
- Capable of using and reading precision measuring devices, such as micrometers and calipers
- Ability to lift up to 75 pounds frequently
- Capable of wearing personal protection equipment, including a respirator
- Capable of working outdoors, and possibly in inclement weather
- Available to work overtime hours - after 5:00 p.m., weekends, holidays
- Valid driver's license, good driving record and ability to obtain DOT certification
- Competency at filling in paperwork and communicating effectively
- Understanding of exploded diagrams or cross-sectional drawings
